# Executive Summary

In 2025, Eagle Sight Charity continued to embody its motto “Let Love Lead” by reaching vulnerable children and communities across Tanzania. Through grassroots support and transparent stewardship, the organization impacted 103 children with health, education, and advocacy programs.

## Key Highlights

- Charity Events: Supported 60 children in Bagamoyo and 43 children at Muhimbili National Hospital.
- Education: Distributed learning materials and mentorship to children in schools and communities.
- Advocacy: Produced a documentary amplifying the voices and resilience of vulnerable children.
- Financial Transparency: Raised TZS 3,124,000, spent TZS 3,104,000, leaving a surplus of TZS 20,000.

## Evaluation

- Strengths: Strong community support, transparent reporting, direct impact, storytelling.
- Challenges: Limited resources, high logistics costs, need for sustainable partnerships.
- Lessons Learned: Grassroots support is powerful but needs scaling; transparency builds donor confidence; advocacy increases visibility.

## Outlook for 2026

Eagle Sight Charity aims to expand its reach to at least 250 children, host a charity event outside Dar es Salaam, produce 10 documentaries, and strengthen partnerships aligned with SDGs 1, 2, 3, 4, 5, 6, 10, and 17. 2025 was a year of love in action. With transparency, grassroots support, and alignment to global goals, Eagle Sight Charity is poised to expand its reach and deepen its impact in 2026.

Eagle Sight Charity is a community-based organization dedicated to empowering vulnerable children and communities. We focus on:



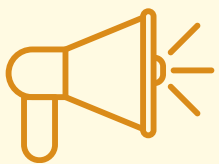
